Beginning in early 2001 we have implemented an approval process for all adults that accompany boys to District events. All adults attending a Royal Rangers (overnight) function must have the written approval of a local pastor. This is taken care of in the charter packet for those who routinely work with boys in the local church. From time to time dads and other men that we are not acquainted with attend Royal Ranger activities. We need to secure a copy of a -Youth Workers Screening Form- from that church or a statement from the pastor approving them to represent his church and the Royal Rangers ministry.

CERTIFICATION FOR ADULT CHURCH WORKER

(Adult leaders are considered 18 years of age or older)
